



Internationals (ICDC) Itinerary

Because Monta Vista DECA is sending a very large delegation to Internationals, we will be traveling to the conference on two separate flights. Please note your assigned flight and ensure that you arrive on time and at the *correct airport* to board your flight.

Switching flights is *not possible at this time*.

Overview

Transportation

We will be flying from the Bay Area (either San Francisco or San Jose) to Indianapolis, IN to connect onto a charter bus to Louisville, KY. Because of the relatively small market for travelers in Louisville and Indianapolis, we will be taking a connecting flight.

Please make sure you that you stay with the group while at connecting airports.

Identification

In order to clear TSA security, you will *need* a valid, photo ID. A Monta Vista student ID will suffice.

Baggage

Most American airlines no longer allow passengers to check baggage free of charge. Please refer to your specific flight listing to look up the additional fees you will be responsible for paying for your baggage. **Your baggage fees are *not* included in your conference registration.**

Checked Baggage

This is baggage that will *not* be traveling with you in the cabin. You will not be able to access it for the duration of your flight and during the connection. For the majority of you, you will be bringing a single piece of checked baggage to hold your formal wear, clothes, and school textbooks.

Carryon Baggage

This is baggage that you will bring with you into the cabin. Because you will have access to them during your flight, there are many restrictions on liquids and items which cannot be carried on board. (Each passenger will be allowed a single, clear, quart-sized plastic bag filled with liquids and gels in clear containers, with each container not exceeding 3 fluid ounces in capacity.) In general, these bags must be much lighter and smaller than checked baggage.

Personal Item

This is a small item which may accompany you on board the aircraft. Examples include purses and laptop bags.

School

You will be missing class from Friday, April 23 to Wednesday, April 28, 2010. Mr. Schmidt will be excusing you from class for the duration of the trip; however, we recommend that you let your teachers know ahead of time and obtain the homework beforehand to help ease your stress upon your return.

Frequent Flyer Mileage

We will not be adding frequent flyer mileage information for you. If you (not your parent, *you*) have frequent flyer membership, you will be responsible for contacting the airline to add the information on your own.
